# White Wines



- 105. Lomas Carrera Sauvignon Blanc - Chile 1** £19.90  
Elegant tropical aromas of citrus fruits with subtle floral notes. Crisp, dry refreshing palate that's full of grapefruit flavours with a soft vanilla finish.
- 106. Mirabello Pinot Grigio - Italy 1** £19.90  
Nicely rounded fresh, crisp, easy-drinking style that is softly perfumed with delicate, fresh, citrus and tropical fruit flavours.
- 107. Cape Marlin Chenin Blanc 2** £21.90  
Clean and lily with lemon and lime characters and a pleasing finish. Fragrant and aromatic with tangerine, yellow and red plums and nectarine. Fruit forward and juicy with well-balanced acidity.
- 108. Three Stones Sauvignon Blanc - New Zealand 1** £22.90  
This luscious Sauvignon Blanc combines intense white peach and nectarine aromas with beautiful fresh, zingy, gooseberry fruit to provide a full palate and lingering finish.
- 109. La Colombe Chablis - France** £23.90  
Typical of what good Chablis should taste like - not a trace of oak, pungent and flinty on the nose with a tad of creamy fruit underneath, this gets richer as the mineral characters give way to a gently fruity core.

# Rose Wines

- 112. San Vigilio Pinot Grigio Blush - Italy 1** £19.90  
Elegant scented peachy, floral characters on the nose and juicy, ripe berry fruits which fill the palate with good acidity and an off dry finish.
- 113. 770 Miles Zinfandel Rose - U.S.A 4** £19.90  
Californian style, soft, fruity rose with juicy strawberry and melon fruit and a delicate medium sweet finish.

# Red Wines

- 114. Mountbridge Reserve - Australia C** £21.90  
A well crafted shiraz with rich plummy fruits and hints of spicy and cracked black pepper.
- 115. Pablo Y Walter - Argentina C** £22.90  
A celebration of Mendoza - the colour, culture and flavour and a celebration of friendship. A really pure expression of Malbec, bright red and juicy, rich chocolate flavours with a lick of oak to round out the edges. Muy, muy fantastic - richly bloody, vibrant latin and velveteen.
- 118. Vega del Rayo Reserva Rioja - Spain D** £26.90  
Richly flavoured and spicy, this classic Rioja, barrel aged in American and Russian oak, combines ripe plum and dried fruit flavours with cinnamon and vanilla.
- 119. Neptune Point - Pinot Noir - Marlborough C** £24.90  
Smooth and perfectly balanced with cherry and plum fruits complemented by mushroom and forest-floor aromas.
- 121. McPherson Merlot - Australia E** £31.90  
Smooth blackberry and stewed plum flavours are complemented with notes of black cherry and fruitcake. Supple and soft with a savoury, spicy finish.

Fruity aromas of apple and papaya lead to a crisp palate full of fresh tropical peach flavours, the lingering finish ends with a touch of sweetness.

**127. Beyond the River Shiraz - Australia** **C**      **£21.90**  
Aromas of dark, ripe blackberries and a hint of peppery spice. Very welcoming on the palate with wonderful, smooth, mellow deep, rich flavours of jammy fruit and a hint of spice. At the finish, lovely soft tannins that leave you wanting more!



# Sparkling Wines

No wine region in the world apart from Champagne is solely dedicated to the production of sparkling wine; they are nonetheless made in nearly every wine region in the world. The consumption of Sparkling Wines has seen considerable growth in recent years and much of that growth has been via Prosecco, which has seen a remarkable global renaissance in popularity.

With fresh, delicate aromas of lemon, apple and white nectarine, this delightful Champagne displays plenty of character on the palate.		
<b>12. Jules Feraud Brut NV</b>	-	<b>£34.90</b>
Award winning, biscuity champagne, rich with savoury aromas this deep, golden Champagne is powerful but elegant. Fresh, fun and lively ideal for any occasion and deliciously easy to drink.		
<b>13. Moet et Chandon Brut Imperial N.V</b>	-	<b>£55.00</b>
The bouquet reveals bright white-fleshed fruits including apple, pear and white peach, citrus fruits, floral lime blossom and elegant notes of brioche and fresh nuts. The palate is flavourful and smooth combining generosity and elegance, followed by a delicately fresh crispiness.		
<b>14. Moet et Chandon Rose Imperial N.V</b>	-	<b>£60.00</b>
With pink copper hues and a lively expressive aroma this is an elegant zesty rose wine with notes of wild strawberry.		
<b>24. Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin Brut NV</b>	-	<b>£70.00</b>
A beautiful golden-yellow colour, with a foaming necklace of tiny bubbles. The nose is initially reminiscent of white fruits and raisins, then of vanilla and later of brioche. The first sip delivers all the freshness and forcefulness so typical of Yellow Label with a symphony of fruit tastes following on.		
<b>25. Veuve Clicquot Rose NV .70cl</b>	-	<b>£.70.00</b>
Madame Clicquot created the first blended Rosé in 1818 by adding some red wine to Yellow Label champagne. The result was Veuve Clicquot Rosé, a fruity and full-bodied expression of the Veuve Clicquot style.		
<b>27. Laurent Perrier Rose NV</b>	-	<b>£89.90</b>
This wonderful pink champagne is pale salmon in colour, with precise, crisp aromas of strawberries, redcurrants, raspberries and black cherries. Fine bubbles with a persistent mousse and prominent flavours of soft red berry fruit, with a well defined wild cherry character.		
<b>30. Dom Perignon 2002 Vintage Brut</b>	-	<b>£170.00</b>
Vintage Brut Intensely floral, with perfumed jasmine that dominates the bouquet. With time in the glass the wine gains richness as the flavours turn decidedly riper and almost tropical. Ripe apricots, passion-fruit and peaches merge from this flashy, opulent Dom Perignon.		
<b>31. Louis Roederer Cristal Brut NV</b>	-	<b>£260.00</b>
Created in 1876 for Tsar Alexander II, this is champagne at its finest. An intensely floral bouquet fragrant with almonds, hazelnuts and wild flowers is complemented by a touch of acidity to mark a finish of elegant persistence.
